480 Seniors Are Graduated From SHS

Savannah High School awarded diplomas to over 480 graduates last night before a full audience in Grayson Stadium

Eighteen students were introduced as top honor graduates. Four of these made an all-A average through the four high school years: Harleston Cabaniss, Donald Gray, Helen Holloman and Madelyn Jones.

According to Savannah High's system of ranking honor students, two tied for fifth place: Christopher Bobo and Brenda Bargeron. Two tied for seventh place: James Cain and Patricia Hart. Two tied for ninth: Clem Hall and Michele Zaro.

Four tied for 11th: Cheryl Richman, Edward Simmons, Carlisle Thacker and Raymond Thomas and four tied for 15th: Sherrie Davis, Judy Nelson, Rupert McLaughlin and John Williams. None of the last 14 students made more than two B's during the four years. All other grades were A's.
